Religion Information Competition April 4, 2023

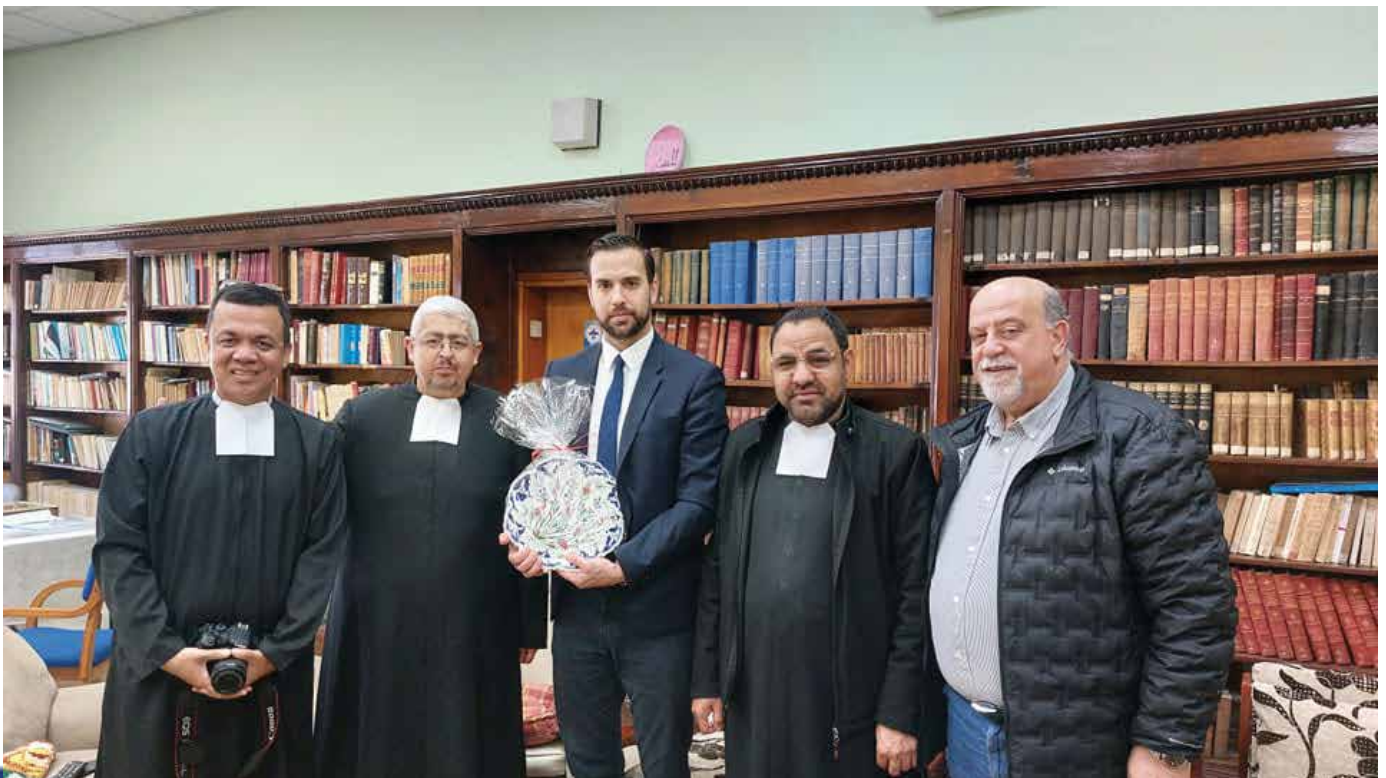
