Basketball Tournament Novembre 30, 2024

The Jerusalem Schools Basketball Tournament for Boys was an exceptional celebration with the slogan "Jerusalem First." The tournament was sponsored by Brother Daoud Kassabry, the principal of the Frère School Jerusalem, who supported, attended, and encouraged the event. It was organized by the Frère School Jerusalem in New Gate and was overseen and sponsored by the De La Salle Jerusalem Club through its unwavering commitment to reviving school sports in Jerusalem / New Gate.

Five participating teams arrived at the Frère School Bab al-Jadid gymnasium from early Friday morning, alongside dozens of committee members, referees, and volunteers who all ensured the tournament's smooth operation and success. The five participating teams included our team, Frère School Beit Hanina, Al-Rashidiya, Terra Sancta Old City, and Ibdah for Sciences and Arts.

The event was a truly remarkable and historic day for Jerusalem, marking the first step in reviving school sports in the city. The most notable aspect of the event was the sportsmanship displayed by everyone, as well as the brotherly spirit that prevailed throughout the tournament.

The teams were divided into two groups, with Frère Jerusalem defeating Terra Sancta and Ibdah for Sciences and Arts. Terra Sancta also triumphed over Ibdah. Additionally, Al-Rashidiya beat Frère Beit Hanina.

After a lunch break attended by all the teams, organizers, and volunteers, the tournament proceeded to its second round. In the semifinals, Al-Rashidiya defeated Terra Sancta, and Frère Jerusalem won against Frère Beit Hanina in a match that was considered a "preliminary final" of the tournament under the supervision of Brother Daoud, director.

The final match was between Al-Rashidiya and Frère Jerusalem. Both teams delivered an excellent performance, keeping the score close until the final moments, when Al-Rashidiya emerged victorious with a 45-43 win.

Brother Daoud Kassabry, along with As'ad Awies, principal of Al-Rashidiya School, and members of the De La Salle Jerusalem Club's administration and sports committee, presented the first-place trophy and medals to Al-Rashidiya's team and the second-place awards to Frère Jerusalem. Prior to the awards ceremony, Brother Daoud expressed his gratitude towards the participating teams, organizers, referees, and everyone involved in ensuring the tournament's success, concluding with the statement that "Jerusalem won," emphasizing that the success was a genuine expression of national belonging.
