Welcoming of the French Solidarity Delegations December 22, 2025

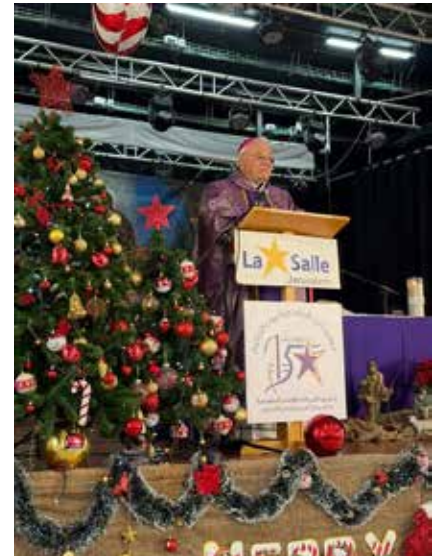
